

SPONSORSHIP OPTIONS

We are delighted that you are considering sponsoring a child and you cannot imagine the difference it makes. Not only in making the child financially secure but also so they feel someone is out there caring for them, giving them a feeling of security. There are approx 300 child places at the school and the school is always full.

Currently out of a number of 305, 90+ are sponsored, some by guardians or relatives of the children that can afford to do so.

SPONSORING A CHILD PLACE

Some children at the school are not always present. Some may be part of a nomadic tribe which means they may spend many months away from the school. Some may be quite poorly and spend time at home or in hospital. Some children move when their guardians move away. However, for every child that moves away there is always another child to take their place. This is the reason sponsoring a child's place is vital for the school to support those children. This is the perfect choice for Sponsors who do not wish to have direct contact and want to feel they are supporting a child but not being directly involved. It is also perfect for anyone who would like to sponsor a child for a year, say. This option is also ideal for anyone who would like to donate a one off amount to the sponsorship fund.

SPONSORING A SPECIFIC CHILD

This is also important and is suitable for those who wish to be more involved with the child they sponsor. It enables contact, either to receive a picture they have drawn from time to time or to send a small gift to their sponsored child when a sponsor is visiting the school. This way, you get to see the child you sponsor receive your gift. It's especially for children here to see their gifts actually arrive with their sponsored child. It can be so rewarding to sponsor a mentally challenged child.
